Manufacturer – Any business entity which manufactures or assembles, at a facility located in North America, machinery, cutting tools or supplies used in the fabrication or processing of wood or similar materials shall be eligible to apply to become a Manufacturer Member of WMMA, provided, however, that such entity may not be wholly or partially owned, directly or indirectly, by an entity organized under the laws of or headquartered in a jurisdiction outside of North America.

Associate Member (please select one) – The following shall be considered Associate Member categories of membership. Associate Members shall not be entitled to vote, except with respect to the election of an Associate Member representative on the WMMA Board of Directors. Further, no more than one Associate Member may be represented on the Association’s Board of Directors at any one time

Foreign-Owned Manufacturer – Any business entity which, but for its foreign ownership, would be eligible to apply for Manufacturer Membership in the Association, shall be eligible to apply to become a Foreign-Owned Manufacturer Member of WMMA.

Distributor – Any business entity which has a physical presence in North America and distributes or markets to the North American market products manufactured or assembled in North America by business entities eligible for Manufacturer Membership in the Association shall be eligible to apply to become a Distributor Member of WMMA.

Supplier – Any business entity which has a physical facility in North America and supplies products or services to business entities eligible for Manufacturer Membership in the Association, but which itself is not eligible to apply to become a Manufacturer Member of the Association, shall be eligible to apply to become a Supplier Member of WMMA.

Industry Supporter – Any consultant, trade publication or educational institution in North America serving the wood products industry shall be eligible to apply to become an Industry Supporter Member of WMMA.

ALL Members shall have the privileges of membership and their representatives shall have the right to participate in Committees, chair a Committee/Task Force or hold office in the Association including be Directors subject to By-Laws.

ALL Members are also eligible for Member discounts on booth rentals at the Association-sponsored International Woodworking Fair – USA and other association related events or programs.
